FOOD for Lane County supports a community network of food pantries, serving **free** + nutritionally balanced food + meals. These pantries are open to the public + income guidelines apply. To see if you are eligible, see guidelines below.

You can still get food if you are without a permanent residence. You don't have to show identification or prove your income. You don't have to have or show a social security number. You can still visit a pantry if you're receiving other benefits, such as food stamps or WIC.

Some of our partners listed below provide other services + may ask for more information for those services. **If you do not wish to provide this information, please state you'd like to receive food only.** If you are not able to leave your home + need food, please call FOOD for Lane County at **541-343-2822**.
